

# **CARMEL CONVENT SR. SEC. SCHOOL, NEEMUCH (M.P.) ANNUAL REPORT 2024–25**

**(From April 2024 to January 2026)**

## **April 2024 – A Promising Beginning**

The new academic session commenced on **4th April 2024** with renewed hopes, enthusiasm, and commitment to excellence. On **6th April**, the spirit of dedication was celebrated when **10 devoted staff members** were honoured with certificates and cash awards for achieving **100% attendance**, conferred by the Principal **Rev. Sr. Jaya CTC** and the Management. Academic brilliance was applauded on **8th April**, as toppers of all classes from **Nursery to IX and XI** were felicitated with certificates. Adding another feather to the institution's cap, the **Playway School was inaugurated on 12th April**, marking a joyful milestone in early childhood education.

## **May 2024 – Academic Excellence and Awareness**

May brought pride and accomplishment with the declaration of **CBSE Results on 13th May**. A total of **164 students appeared for Class XII** and **330 students for Class X**, achieving commendable results. In **Class XII**, **Aksh Ladha (Commerce)** emerged as the topper with **96.8%**, while **Hussain Moni (Science)** secured **94.6%**. In **Class X**, **Anant Somani** topped with an impressive **96.8%**. Professional development was strengthened through a **Teachers' Seminar on 22nd May**. The school reopened after summer vacation on **24th May**, and an **Awareness Programme by MP Police, Neemuch on 25th May** sensitized students on safety and civic responsibility.

## **June 2024 – Health, Transition and Leadership**

On **28th June**, a **Free Blood Test Camp** for students and staff was organised by the **Health Department, MP**, emphasizing health awareness. This month also witnessed a significant administrative transition. **Rev. Sr. Cecil**, the respected Manager, was accorded a heartfelt and memorable farewell. **Rev. Sr. Archana** graciously took charge and was warmly welcomed by the Carmelite family.

## **July 2024 – Leadership, Learning and Legacy**

July unfolded with democratic values as **Student Leaders were elected on 4th July**. On **5th July**, students benefited from an inspiring **Career Counselling Session** by **Mr. Ritesh Jain**, Harvard Alumni and motivational mentor. A grand farewell was organised on **7th July** by Carmelites and **ACCAN (Alumni of Carmel)** in honour of the beloved Principal **Rev. Sr. Jaya CTC**. The leadership baton was passed on **8th July**, when **Rev. Sr. Saumya** assumed charge as the new Principal and was warmly welcomed.

Environmental consciousness was nurtured through **Vanamahotsav on 10th July**, with plantation drives and the **National Paryavaran Quiz** organised by the **Science, Seva, and Eco**

**Clubs.** Creativity blossomed during the **Inter-House Rakhi Making Competition on 12th July**, followed by a **PT Meeting on 13th July**. **Guru Poornima on 20th July** was marked by honouring senior teachers. The **44th Foundation Day of Carmel** was joyously celebrated on **3rd August**. Patriotic fervour filled the campus on **15th August**, as the **78th Independence Day** was celebrated with zeal. The school achieved laurels by winning **First Prize in an Inter-School Dance Competition** organised by the Municipal Authority, Neemuch. Parent-teacher collaboration continued with a **PT Meeting on 24th August**. Cultural richness was highlighted through **Janmashtami celebrations on 26th August**, and sporting spirit was ignited on **29th August**, when **National Sports Day** was observed with an **Inter-House Hockey Match for boys**.

### **September 2024 – Knowledge, Sports and Service**

Students celebrated **Teachers' Day on 5th September** with heartfelt gratitude through cultural performances. On **6th September**, Carmel Convent achieved distinction by winning the **CBSE Cluster Badminton Tournament in Bhopal**. Students showcased sporting excellence at the **SGFI Divisional Basketball Tournament in Ujjain on 20th September**, with four students qualifying for the state level.

From **23rd September to 2nd October**, **Gandhi Jayanti Week** was observed with cultural and social activities commemorating the **155th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi**, including cleanliness drives by **SEVA, Eco, and Science Clubs**. The **Mid-Term Examination** was conducted from **24th September to 7th October**. Students also participated in **SGFI Divisional Cricket and State-level Karate Tournaments from 28th September to 3rd October**.

### **October 2024 – Festivity, Training and Sporting Glory**

The festive spirit of **Diwali** was celebrated on **19th October** with creative activities like **Thali, Diya, and Pot Decoration**. A **Four-Day Staff Training Programme on Learning vs Education** was organised on **23rd October**. From **3rd to 17th October**, students excelled in **SGFI State-Level Softball, Netball, Badminton, and Divisional Cricket Tournaments**. Special mention goes to **Gauranshi Sharma (Class VIII)**, selected for the **68th National Basketball Competition in Chhattisgarh**, and another student who represented the school at the **National Swimming Competition**.

### **November 2024 – Child-Centric and Constitutional Values**

**Children's Day on 14th November** was celebrated with joy as the Principal, Management, and Staff organised delightful activities for students. On **25th November**, a **Health and Hygiene Seminar for Girl Students** was conducted. The month concluded with the

observation of the **75th Anniversary of the Indian Constitution from 26th to 30th November**, marked by various educational and value-based activities.

## **December 2024**

The month of December was marked by academic display, sportsmanship, and intellectual participation. The school organised its **Annual Exhibition titled “A Gallery Gala of Carmel” on 19 December 2024**. The exhibition was graced by **Mr. Himanshu Chandra, IAS, District Collector, Neemuch**, as the **Chief Guest**, and **Mr. Santosh Chopra, Ex-Municipal Chairman**, as the **Guest of Honour**. Exhibits prepared by students from all faculties—**Science, Languages, Social Sciences, Commerce, Art, Music, and Dance**—were showcased. To encourage parent participation, **Rangoli Making and Salad Decoration competitions** were also conducted.

The **Annual Athletic Meet for Classes I to XII** was successfully conducted on **20 and 21 December 2024**, promoting physical fitness, teamwork, and sportsmanship among students. Further, students actively participated in the **MP Government Essay Competition on “Viksit Madhya Pradesh 2047” on 26 December 2024**, reflecting their awareness of national development goals.

## **January 2025**
